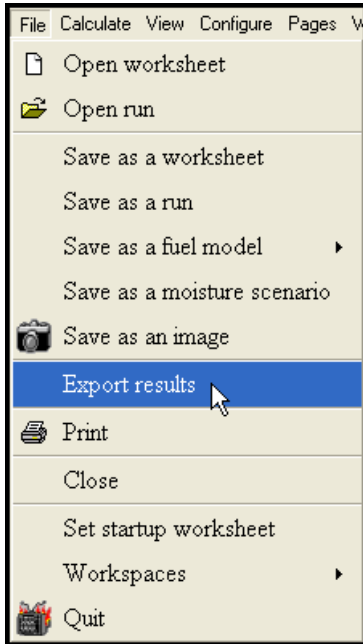



Print HTML with shading

This tip describes how to set up your browser to display HTML table shading on printed output.

You can export BehavePlus tables in HTML format.



The shading in the HTML document looks good on the screen. In order for the shading to show in a printed copy, you may need to change your browser settings.

Using Internet Explorer:

- Select **Tools > Internet Options**.
- Select the **Advanced** tab.
- Scroll down to the **Printing** header.
- Enable the check box titled **Print background colors and images**.
- Click **Apply**.
- Click **OK**.

Using Mozilla FireFox:

- Select **File > Page Setup**.
- Select the **Format & Options** tab.
- Enable the check box titled **Print Background (colors and images)**.
- Click **OK**.
