

Using Adobe PDF Products Effectively with BehavePlus


Many of the documents associated with the BehavePlus fire modeling system are PDF accessible and can be either printed or viewed interactively using a PDF viewer. You can download a free copy of Acrobat Reader from Adobe's website (<http://www.adobe.com>) and clicking on the icon that says "Get ADOBE READER".

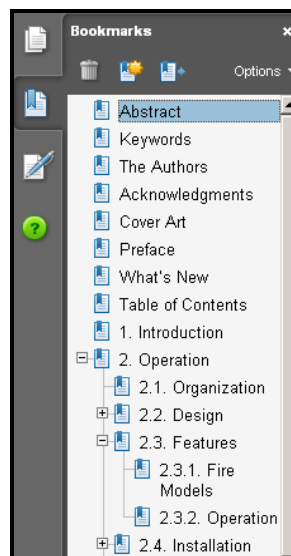


Note: The following guidelines work for both Adobe Acrobat Professional version 8.1.1 and Adobe Reader version 8.2. If your version of Adobe Reader is older than version 8.2, you should update Adobe Reader for security reasons.

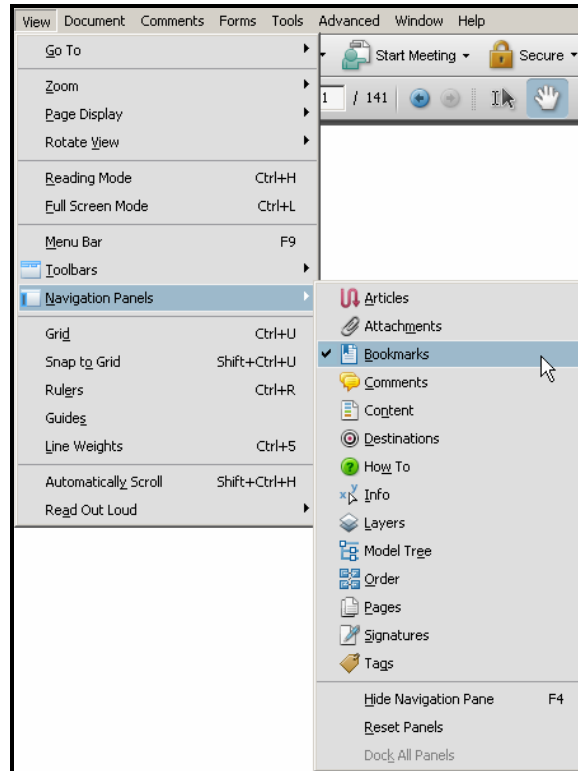
Bookmarks

The content menu on the left-hand side of either Adobe product contains bookmarks









() , which provide easy access to individual sections and subsections of a document, allowing the user to quickly find the exact information needed. The sections can be expanded by clicking on the + sign next to the section header. While not all PDF documents are formatted to contain bookmarks, both the User's Guide and the *BehavePlus fire modeling system, version 4.0: Variables* paper have bookmarks to allow for easy navigation.



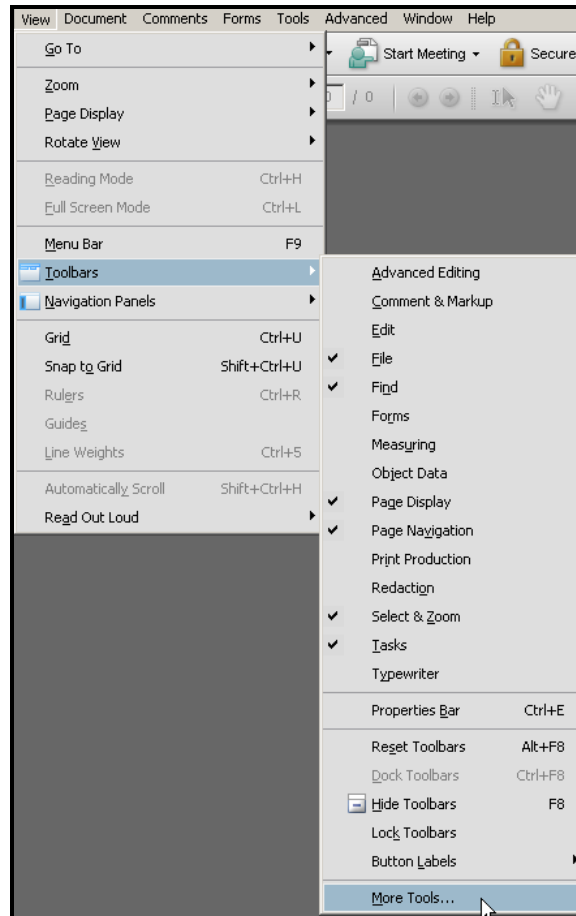
- If the bookmarks do not appear when you open a document in Adobe Acrobat Reader, place a checkmark next to **View > Navigation Panels > Bookmarks** (as shown below). The bookmark icon should then appear on the left-hand side of the window. You can expand the bookmarks by clicking on the icon.



Page Navigation Toolbar

- The arrow keys () on the **Page Navigation Toolbar** allow you move to the **first** (), **previous** (), **next** (), or **last** () page. The keys with arrows inside circles () in the tool bar allow you to move backward (**previous view** ) or forward (**next view** ) through any jumps you have made via embedded bookmarks or links.

- You can choose which buttons appear on the Page Navigation Toolbar by clicking on **View > Toolbars > More Tools...**, and then scrolling down to the options for **Page Navigation Toolbar**.



- Finally, check the box next to each option you wish to display. To obtain maximum flexibility in browsing, click all of the boxes as shown below and click **OK**.
